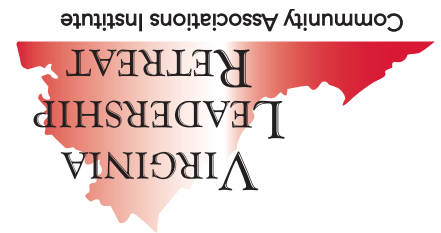


What's Your Personality Color?
